

**Division I Strength and Conditioning Coaches
Attendance at CSCCa Convention During Temporary COVID-19 Recruiting Dead Period**

UPDATED MAY 3, 2021

Staff has received several inquiries to determine if in-person attendance of NCAA Division I strength and conditioning coaches is permissible at the Collegiate Strength and Conditioning Coaches Association (CSCCa) Convention May 5-7, 2021.

The CSCCa recently informed the national office staff that steps have been taken to ensure coaches of prospective student-athletes will not attend the convention in-person and these coaches will only be provided the option to attend virtually.

Member institutions are encouraged to conduct an analysis to determine if the attendance of the coaches satisfies previous guidance provided by the Council Coordination Committee and should adhere to federal, state, local and other applicable guidelines related to COVID-19.

Application of Temporary Dead Period to In-Person Attendance at a National Convention. The NCAA Division I Council Coordination Committee discussed the application of the temporary dead period to in-person attendance of strength and conditioning coaches at a national convention that includes coaches of prospective student-athletes. The Coordination Committee agreed that the temporary COVID-19 dead period precludes strength and conditioning coaches from in-person attendance at a national convention that includes coaches of prospective student-athletes.
